ON SUCCESS***

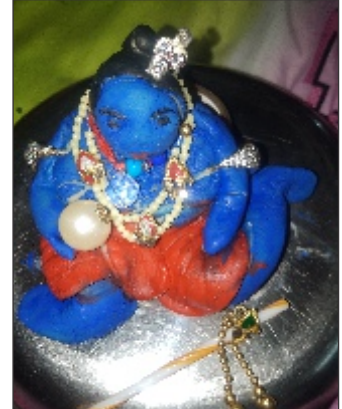
