One of the first conditions of happiness is that the link between man and nature shall not be broken.”



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Environmental Week Celebration-Day2




DPSS-HRDC Workshop on 'Step by Step Fun with Writing'

It was an engaging and engrossing session where the emphasis was laid on amending the pattern of developing the writing skills of students. To change the trend, she suggested to invest if not more, then at least an equal amount of time for writing skills as we do for textbooks and grammar. The outcome will be gradual but positive results can be achieved by developing writing through Art Integration. She showed an exemplar as to how essay writing can be practiced by classifying the data step by step. The objective was to implement it with students so that they feel and express things from their perspective.

DPSS-HRDC Workshop on 'Teaching English Prose'

A workshop on the topic "Teaching English Prose" was conducted by DPSS-HRDC on 09.06.2021 and attended by our Teacher Mr. Saikat Roy. The Resource Person was Prof. Samson Thomas from Hyderabad, EFLU. He focused on the ways to make a prose piece attractive. He also pointed out several important ways to drag the listener's attention towards a prose. Moreover, he threw light upon linguistic intelligence, the process of learning and language acquisition. In particular, the training outlined the methodology of learning through immersion and discovery. A lively question answer session followed the presentation by the resource person.

 - > Effects



The teacher gained immensely from the knowledge dissemination during the two hour long online webinar conducted by the DPS Society, New Delhi..





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

Yoga Session for Parents and Students




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

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9TH FOUNDATION DAY CELEBRATION



