4. Write the Hindu – Arabic numerals for the following:

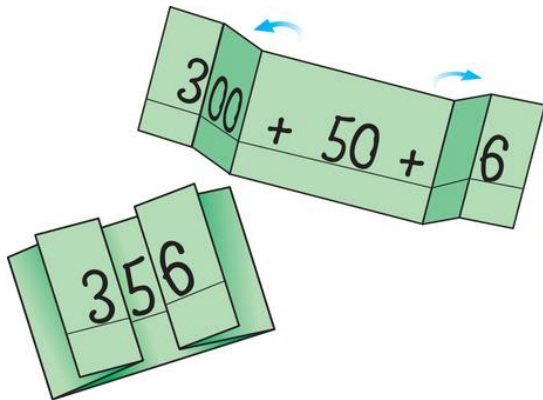

2. Observe the picture and answer the questions that follow:

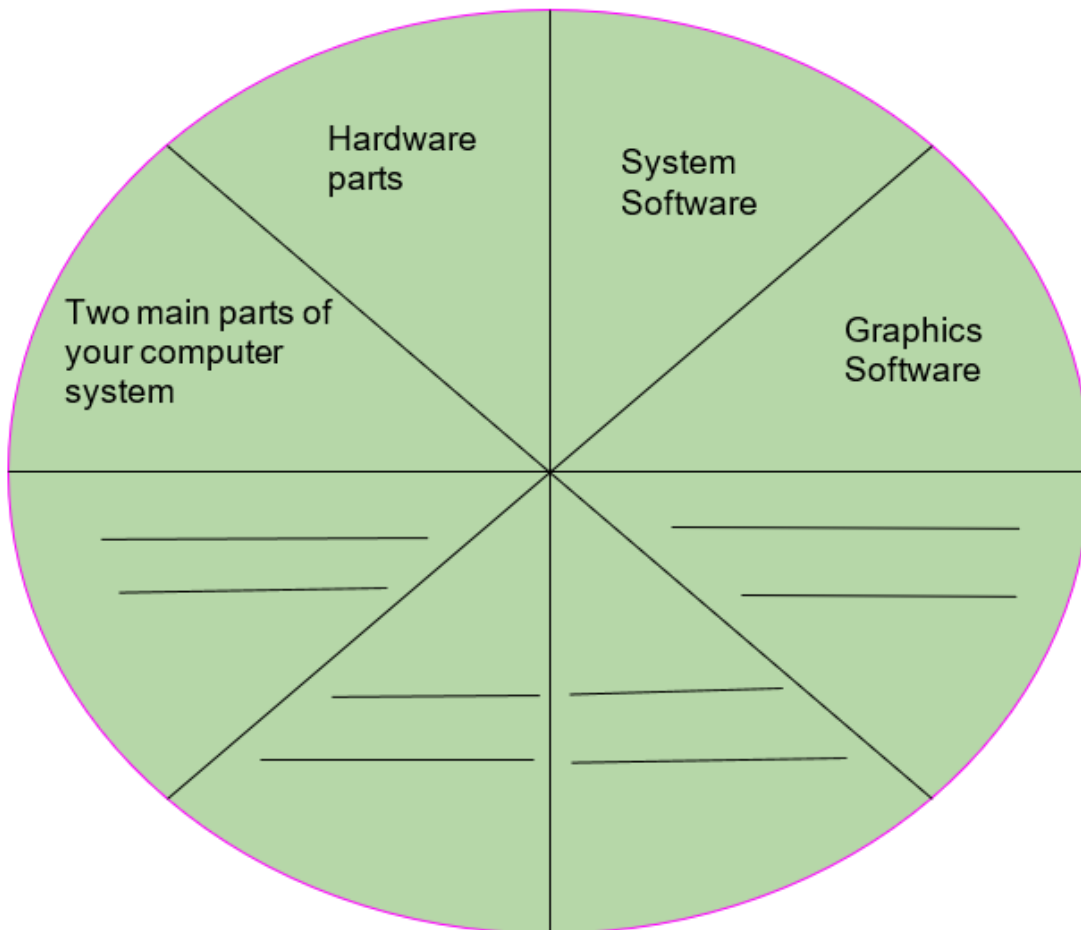


- (a) Do you think these children attend school?
