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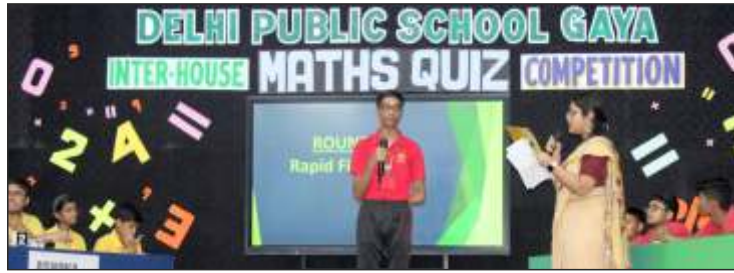
### Inter-House Mathematics Quiz Competition

### अंतर-सदन हिन्दी वाद-विवाद प्रतियोगिता

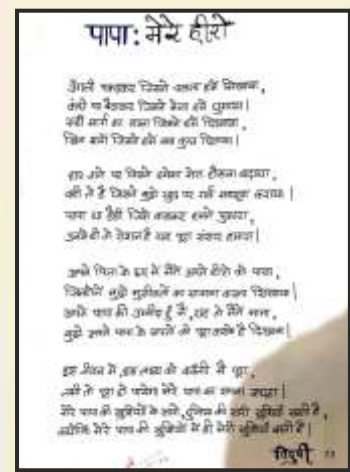
### Die Stadt (Storm)
